1. Discuss:

3. Discuss:

 - Aside from the bad ideas we discussed in this series, what other obstacles could stand in the way of people getting to know God?
 - What other obstacles have you (or your close friends or family) personally experienced?
 - What have you discovered through this series about your own level of comfort or discomfort in facing these obstacles?

HUDDLE

4. Bruxy's final question asked about practical next steps we can take to start conversations about Jesus. Guide the students to brainstorm or see what they remember from the teaching, and then use the lists below to aid in your conversation. You could also role play some ideas.
 - With whom and where could you discuss Jesus with others?
 - Family and friends
 - Work and school
 - Social media (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram)
 - Cold turkey
 - How do you begin a conversation with someone about Jesus?
 - Talk about what you're learning
 - Offer them a book
 - Invite them to church, youth, and/or Christmas!
