

**HANGOUT**

1. Discuss:
  - What stood out the most to you from the teaching? Why?
  - Have you heard this story before? If so, did anything new stand out to you? What was it?
  - What is hospitality? How do you experience or show hospitality in your life?
2. Recap the how, who, and why of hospitality (i.e., How do you do it? Who do you do it for? Why do you do it?).

**HEAR**

3. Look up and read Genesis 18:1-8.
4. Discuss:
  - Which part of this story stands out the most to you?
  - How does Abraham offer hospitality to his guests? How long do you think it might have taken? What do you think they did during that time?
5. Look up and read a few Bible verses about hospitality (e.g., Matthew 25:35; Luke 14:12-14; and Hebrews 13:2).
6. Discuss:
  - How have you been shown the kind of God-loving hospitality that Abraham shows?
  - When have you shown that kind of hospitality to someone else? How did you do it?
  - In today's culture, what is most challenging about practising radical hospitality? What could we do about it?
  - Which is easier for you: generosity (i.e., giving away money or possessions) or hospitality (i.e., using what you have to serve others)? Why do you think that is?

**HUDDLE**

7. Encourage your group to discuss how they've served others and loved well (including things such as serving at church, investing time in family, helping friends, showing kindness to strangers, or loving enemies) in the past week.
8. Pray for one another about the things the students shared.
