

This two-week series focuses on The Meeting House's new Go campaign. The campaign's purpose is to introduce spiritually curious people to the Jesus-centred life through a movement of Jesus-centred churches. To translate that for a youth setting, Go will help our friends learn about Jesus and welcome them wholeheartedly into the community.

HANGOUT

1. Discuss:
 - What have you been invited to that was really cool? Have you ever invited someone to something that was really cool for them? If so, what was it?
 - Do you have any friends you'd describe as "spiritually curious"? What do you think that description means?

HEAR

2. Look up and read Luke 14:15-24 together.
3. Discuss:
 - What excuses do we make for not spending time with Jesus or our church community?
 - Do you see yourself in this story? If so, who and why?
 - Who are the people who will come and want to be invited to the table?
 - What are some barriers or assumptions that we may face when we reach out as Christ-followers?
 - What is your view of how God is at work?
 - How do you think the majority of people view the church? How is the church or God or Jesus viewed in your school?
 - Are there any barriers stopping you from being willing to identify as a Christ-follower? If so, what are they?

HUDDLE

4. Discuss:
 - Following Jesus isn't a passive act. It involves getting to know him, getting to know his family (that's the rest of us!), and inviting others to "family dinners" so to speak. What's one way you could invite someone "in"—whether that's to something with your own family or with your church family?
 - Do you sense God saying you may need to change something about how you view yourself or others? If so, what is it?
5. Pray together about what the students have shared and discussed.
