

This week focuses on evangelism. It means different things to people depending on their experiences. Our hope is to understand better what sharing the Good News of Jesus could look like.

Leader Tip: Share a story that shows we don't have to make sharing what we believe weird!

HANGOUT

1. Discuss:
 - Have you heard the word "evangelism" before?
 - What does it mean to you or to your friends?
 - Has anyone ever tried to evangelize you? For example, have Mormons come to your door or have you encountered someone yelling in the city streets or handing out Bible tracks?

HEAR

2. Look up and read Acts 17:16-33 together.
3. Discuss:
 - Does anything about how Paul connected with the people in this city stand out to you?
 - What did you think about the following points Jimmy made from the scripture?
 - Affirming curiosity (verses 22-23)
 - Using common language (verses 24-25)
 - Where is God already at work? (verses 26)
 - Moving to Jesus (verses 29-31)

HUDDLE

4. Discuss this week's Take Outs:
 - Who could you reach out to right now or in the week ahead?
 - What's your next step toward having an honest and kind conversation with your friends about what you believe about Jesus?
5. Encourage everyone to pray for wisdom, grace, and courage for themselves and their fellow group members.
6. Pray together about what the students have discussed and shared.
