

This series highlights the peace teachings of Jesus and how they can shift the ways we act and react in our everyday lives. This week focuses on the love we have for one another.

HANGOUT

1. Discuss:
 - What are some of the different ideas you've heard about love?
 - What does love look like to you?

HEAR

2. Look up and read Romans 12:6-11 together.
3. Discuss:
 - What stands out to you in this passage?
 - Does anything from it ping in your heart?
 - Read verse 9 again. Where might you find this idea unsettling in your own life? With family? At school? With friends? In any other areas?
 - What does it look like to serve the Lord enthusiastically? Who do you know that lives this way? How could you cultivate it? What diminishes this enthusiasm in your life?
4. Talk about the actions you need to take to increase your spiritual enthusiasm (e.g., simplicity, generosity, time, spiritual practices, etc.).
5. Note that the church unified through love is a key theme of Romans 12:9-11.
6. Discuss: Where do you see this working (or not working) in the church today? How about in other areas, such as your family?

HUDDLE

7. Discuss:
 - What's a barrier for how you love God and others?
 - What are some practical ways you can love others—really love them—this week?
8. Pray for your group, including their requests, their burdens, and the week ahead.
